### Check Out This Very Cool Rain Gauge



Garden gurus tell us that most plants, shrubs, and trees do best when they get about an inch of water each week. And what do they suggest we measure water with? A tuna can—yuck!

We prefer to go for something that's a bit more attractive, like the [World's Coolest Rain Gauge](#). Made of solid copper and steel, this rain gauge is based on the [principle of water displacement](#).

Hidden inside the hollow copper flute is a measurement tube that pops up as the flute fills with water. Clearly marked in

¼-inch increments, the tube measures up to 6 inches of water.

Even better is that both the 24-inch stake and 9-inch tabletop model make decorative lawn ornaments all on their own—much prettier than tuna cans, for sure.
